The Parent Leadership Training Institute

The Connecticut Commission on Children was created in 1985 by an act of the Connecticut Legislature to bring representatives from the legislative, executive and judicial branches of government together with the private sector to promote public policies in children's best interest.

In 1992, focused on prevention and capacity building, the Commission created the Parent Leadership Training Institute (PLTI) as a statewide family civics initiative. PLTI is designed to enable parents to become leading advocates for children.



Parents Supporting Educational Excellence

The Connecticut Center for School Change partners with school districts to improve student achievement and sponsors an executive leadership program for superintendents.

Parents Supporting Educational Excellence (Parents SEE) was developed in 2005 by the Center for School Change and the Commission on Children to provide parents with skills and understanding necessary to become leaders, change agents and active participants in education at the school, district and state levels.

Research studies show a clear link between student achievement and parent and family involvement. When schools, families and community groups work together, students do better in school and have a higher probability of success.
